Challenge Skills

Hatching & Crosshatching - The Courthouse

 Use straight, parallel lines (hatching) and overlapping layers of lines at different angles (crosshatching) to create depth, shadows, and texture. This technique is perfect for architectural features like columns, bricks, and windows. Pay attention to light direction — tighter, darker lines suggest shadow, while wider spacing conveys light.

Stippling - Lake De Soto

 Build tone and texture using only dots. Place them closer together for darker, shaded areas, and spread them farther apart for lighter areas. Stippling takes patience but is especially effective for natural subjects like water ripples, trees, and reflections. It's about slowing down and layering your dots to create smooth gradations of light and shadow.

Expressive Linework (Thick & Thin) - The Blanche

 Experiment with line weight to create drama and character. Use thicker, heavier strokes to define structure and bold outlines, and finer lines to capture detail and delicacy. This contrast adds energy and emotion to your drawing. Don't be afraid to exaggerate

 the variation in line quality can truly aid in bringing your subject to life.
